

Seaper Powers

A new children's book series

A new series of children's books called ***Seaper Powers*** has begun to take over the world of imagination. This has become a new children's favorite written by Billboard Artist Kim Cameron, and should not be missed. Three adventures are available in eBook, Paperback, Audio CD, coloring book, and MP3: In Search of Bleu Jay's Treasure; The Mystery of the Blue Pearls; The Rescue; The Riddle.

Written in 1-2 page chapters, these stories are meant to be shared with parents at bedtime. Kids can read the book on their own, or read along with the audio version.

The Author, Kim Cameron, is currently touring schools across the US with her **Seaper Powers Puppet Experience**. It's a perfect show for K-3rd graders.

Seaper Powers: In Search of Bleu Jay's Treasure (book I)

A magical tale about a little girl (Emma) who discovers special sea grass off the island of St. Thomas. It transforms her body so that she can talk to fish! Not only does she make new friends, she sets off on a new adventure to find buried treasure! (K-3rd grade)

Seaper Powers: The Mystery of the Blue Pearls (book II)

The second in the ***Seaper Powers*** series. In this adventure, Emma must save the ruler of the sea after she uncovers a secret city that no human has ever seen before! (1-4th grade)

Seaper Powers: The Rescue (book III)

Emma and her friends continue the adventure...this time they have to find a cure or Steve might die! Using her new friends from books I and II, Emma travels back to the islands where she first found her 'Seaper Powers.' (1-4th grade)

Seaper Powers: The Riddle— (book IV)

Emma, her friends Marty, the merman, Oliver, the octopus, Steve, the starfish, and Wally, the whale, travel to the Florida Keys to solve a mystery that has been guarded for thousands of years. The only way they can find out the truth is to follow a map of riddles. (1-4th grade)

Seaper Powers Book Tour

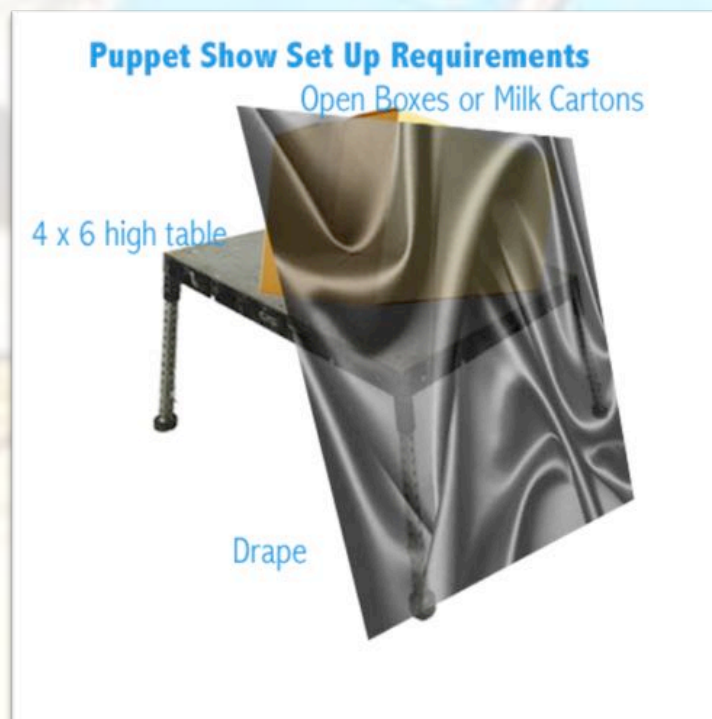
Kim Cameron has toured across the U.S.A with her puppets, from libraries to pre schools, to elementary schools and summer camps.

Kim uses puppets to tell an abridged version of the story (15 minutes in length). At the end, kids sing along to a song that is written for each book, and only available in the audio portion.

Book Reading Requirements

1. School / Facility must have a podium or high table (Libraries or smaller cafeteria's are recommended)
2. No more than 2 sessions per day
3. The visit is confined to one location to eliminate multiple set ups.
4. Each session consists of 15 minutes of book reading and up to 20 minutes of Q&A after
5. Kids are welcome to bring paper for autographs
6. Please provide bottled water
7. Schools must send out a flyer prior to the arrival (refer to last page) and display the books prior to her arrival along with the ordering sheet.

About the Author

Kim Cameron began her career on KHAT TV as a small town reporter after DJ'ing on KRNU. With a journalism degree in hand, she moved to the Washington DC area writing for the Smithsonian Institute. Her career took numerous twists and turns through corporate ladders and organizations, but telling stories was always a passion. She is a proven lyricist with a song catalog of over 65, including a few children's songs. She wrote her first musical in 2012 while writing for the National Examiner and providing the voice over character for an Asian animation movie.

Kim is a true believer in inspiring and nurturing kids. She teaches vocal lessons to students at the School of Rock and volunteers at the Children's Hospital, singing at their bedsides.

While on tour in the Caribbean, she met a 12 year old who had a fascination with octopi. This brief encounter inspired the creation of Mr. Octopus, a children's tune featuring a 7 year old that Kim recently signed to her record label. After completing the song, her co-writer and guitarist, John DePatie, encouraged her to take the song to next level by writing a children's book using the song as the impetus.

After the story was written, John and Kim thought it would be better told using a live narrator and the incorporation of the song. After months of production, narration, editing, the creation of original musical score and sound effects, the audiobook was completed.



While Kim has had many accomplishments, she and John consider this their biggest feat.

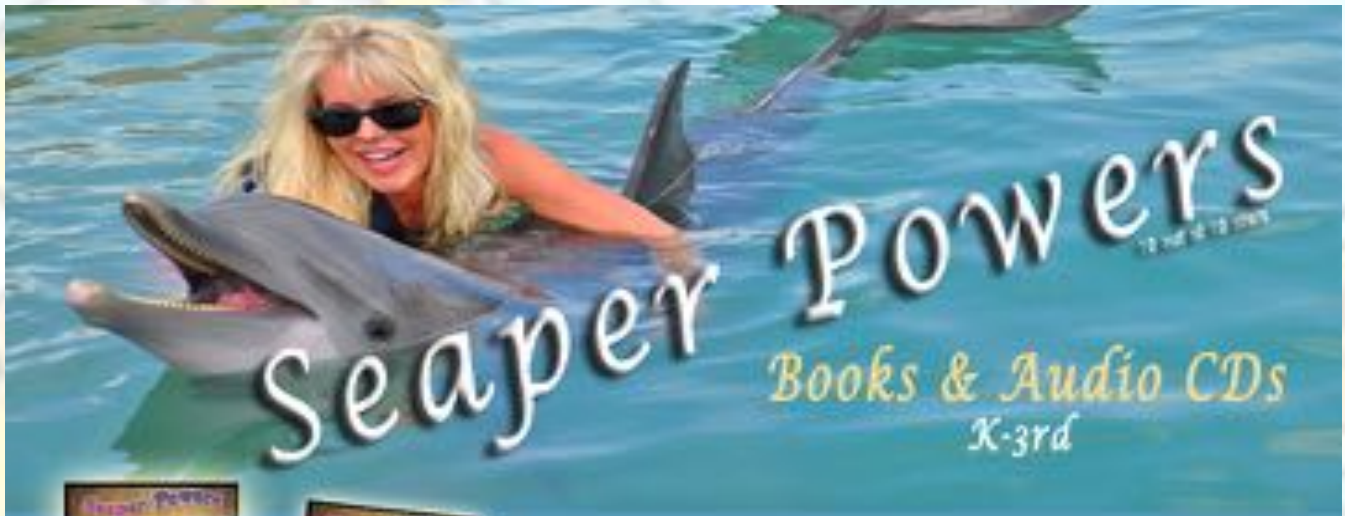
