

Cameron to sing at NFL game

A singer with local ties will be performing the National Anthem during the Pittsburgh Steelers-New York Giants preseason game Saturday.

Kim Cameron, represented by Culpeper agent Timothy Jackson, will sing her second National Anthem during a NFL game at 7:30 in New York.

"I had her booked for the Redskins game with Larry Michaels about two years ago," Jackson said. "Then basically you just look for the contact people, make a few phone calls and put

her information in front of them."

Cameron is a seasoned vocalist, songwriter and children's author. She is a five-time Billboard charting artist with awards from Album of the Year, Best Live Performance and an American Songwriter Finalist, with five albums under her belt and national and international touring experience.

Jackson, who has been her agent for about four years, said it's a huge honor to have a client perform the anthem for an NFL team.

"That's huge level stuff when you do the anthem of the halftime," Jackson said.
