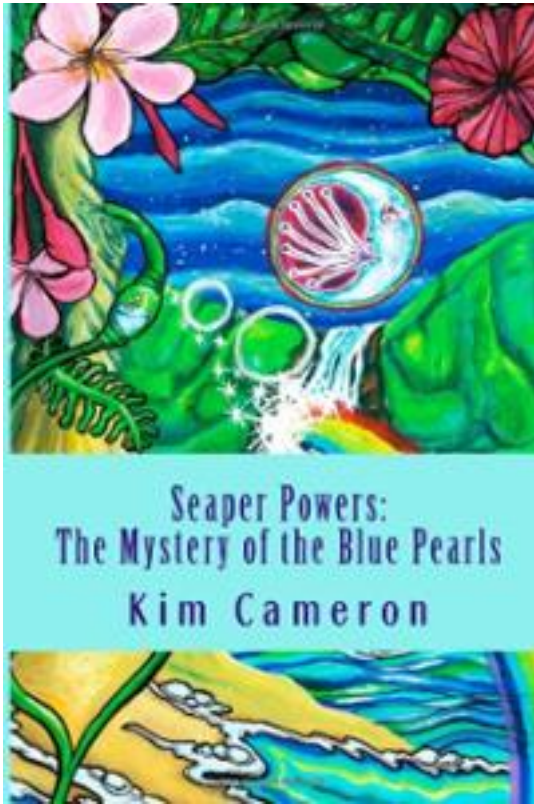


Seaper Powers: The Mystery of the Blue Pearls - Kim Cameron
